## Benefits to Planning Events in Res Halls

- Several of the Halls contain Meeting rooms, Lounges, and Lawns to host events and programs. PV beach, Sonora lawn, and Sahuaro lawn are ideal locations for big events, such as a concert or BBQ. Manzanita, PV East and West, and central campus residence halls all contain classrooms for smaller and personal events.
- There are weekly staff meetings for the Resident Assistants and Graduate Hall Directors. These meetings could be an ideal time for you to spread information about your event. For more information, speak with an RA or Graduate Hall Director in an area near your event.
- All Residential Halls have Hall Council consisting of students living within the halls who plan activities and programs. The Hall Councils welcome new ideas for exciting programs for campus residents.
- All residence halls contain bulletin boards, information tables, and plenty of wall space to hang publicity; before posting publicity for your event, be sure to check out the policies regarding posting in these spaces.
