

Hosting Events with Alcohol

A Policy for Registered Student Organizations

Arizona State University at the Tempe campus

Effective 09/07/2006

In order to host events with alcohol, all ASU registered student organizations must adhere to the following policies:

- A. Student organizations must be in compliance with all federal, state, county, city and university regulations (including STA 106–03: Alcohol and Other Drugs on Campus; ABOR 5-108: Sale and Consumption of Alcoholic Beverages on Campus; and, DPS 202–03: Sales and Service of Alcoholic Beverages on Campus) as well as any national organization alcohol/risk management policies that apply.
- B. Student organizations must also be in compliance with Arizona State University Tempe campus “Procedures for Student Organization Events with Alcohol.” This includes the use of a third party vendor to serve alcohol and must include documented compliance of all “Third Party Vendor Checklist” items.
- C. No bring your own beverage (BYOB) events will be permitted.
- D. This policy applies to any registered student organization event/activity that:
 - a. Occurs on property owned, operated or used by Arizona State University;
 - b. Occurs at a location used as a primary organization facility and/or residence or at a third-party vendor location;
 - c. An objective observer would construe as organization-related;
 - d. And/or alcohol will be served;
 - e. And/or organization members planned, pre-meditated, coordinated, promoted, advertised through the membership, discussed at organization meeting or executive board meeting;
 - f. And/or if organization funds are used in any way;
 - g. And/or a band, DJ or other form of entertainment will be present.

Any exception to the above policy must be approved in writing by the Executive Director of the ASU Memorial Union and the organization’s local and/or national advisors.

Student organizations that violate this policy will be subject to disciplinary sanctions in accordance with the Arizona Board of Regents Student Code of Conduct.
