### ***Code of Conduct Violations***

If you are alerted to an ASU Code of Conduct violation or any type of criminal activity you should immediately notify ASU DPS as well as Student Life. Phone calls to local advisers, regional officers, headquarters staff and Fraternity and Sorority Life should follow. All applicable ASU, Maricopa County, State of Arizona and headquarters policies should be followed.

### ***Fraternity and Sorority Life Reporting Protocol***

When the Fraternity and Sorority Life Office is made aware of an alleged critical incident, the Chapter President will be the first individual notified. Adviser and National Headquarters will be notified next. The Fraternity and Sorority Life Office reserves the right to adjust this notification process if the situation warrants such action.

If the Fraternity and Sorority Life Office is notified of alleged activity that compromises the safety of members or non-members, the Chapter President will be notified. A cessation of activities letter may follow. Specific,

alleged activities may not be outlined in the cessation of activities letter. In addition to alerting local, regional and national authorities, if applicable the Department of Public Safety and Student Life will also be notified.

### ***Media Response***

In the event that the media is attempting to interview you or members of your chapter, our recommendation is to follow your organizational policies. Additionally, you should contact your Chapter Adviser and/or National Organization representative. Fraternity and Sorority Life should be contacted as soon as possible.
