GOLF CART THEFTS, TEMPE and POLYTECHNIC CAMPUS

SYNOPSIS

The theft of golf carts has risen dramatically on the ASU Tempe and Polytechnic Campus.

The thefts are occurring overnight and on the weekends. Both new and old carts are being taken. The carts have been later recovered on campus. Most have been damaged.

There have been no suspects identified at this time.

PROTECT YOUR CART

1. **Always remove keys from ignition when not in use.**
2. When the cart is secured at the end of the day, secure it to a solid object with a heavy chain and lock.
3. Use a club-type device to secure the steering wheel or an ignition collar-locking device. While these devices can be defeated, it takes time and effort to do so. **They are excellent deterrents to theft.**
4. If possible, secure the cart in a locked, fenced area.
