This orientation has assisted many new researchers with laboratory setup, waste management and the development of safety procedures. Due to the success of this program, EH&S has decided to open the orientation to established researchers at ASU. The orientation is constantly updated and provides pertinent information for both established researchers and researchers beginning a new area of research.

The orientation provides an opportunity for researchers to meet with Environmental Health & Safety (EH&S) and the Office of Vice President for Research and Economic Affairs (OVPREA) professionals that assist them with compliance with EH&S and research policies and procedures. Participants receive an overview of the various types of regulations and ASU policies affecting research projects, especially those conducted in laboratories and utilizing potentially hazardous materials.

The session establishes a "quick start" to streamline research startup laboratory and/or field research operations. Attending this orientation will help principal investigations, lab managers, and academic professionals establish research operations in a more expedient manner.
