How to dispose of universal waste



Universal waste is:

Waste commonly and frequently generated by the university, including batteries and intact, unbroken light bulbs.

Batteries

1. Collect in a clean, compatible container.

2. Label the container Used Batteries.

3. For large batteries, attach a completed hazardous waste tag.



Bulbs

1. Collect in a clean, compatible container.

2. Label the container Used Light Bulbs.

3. Attach a completed hazardous waste tag.



Broken bulbs are hazardous waste. Contact EHS for assistance. Keep containers closed.
