Stacking boxes in work the area

Many ASU employees stack boxes in work areas to conserve space. When stacking boxes, remember that safety is paramount.



Properly stacked

 Stacked boxes must allow room for clearance in the event of a fire or other emergency.



What to look for

 Ensure that stacked boxes are at least 18 inches away from a sprinkler deflector, shown at right.



What to look for

 Ensure boxes are at least two feet away from a ceiling without a fire sprinkler.





Identify areas where boxes may be stacked improperly: Offices, shops and laboratories.

Consult with office, shop and laboratory mangers to address safety concerns and resolve box stacking hazards.
