

The ASU Biodiversity Assessment has been compiled with [IPaC](#) and [IUCN Red List](#) databases. Boundaries for the assessment include property owned and operated at all four main campuses in Arizona, as well as the Lake Havasu campus. This list will be updated annually to address property boundary changes and any new species identified with critical habitats within ASU property boundaries. This assessment will inform watershed planning, land-use guidelines and invasive species planning.
