

Zero Waste living on campus checklist

In the dorms

- 1. Coordinate with your roommate(s) to ensure you are not bringing the same supplies to share.
- 2. Compost Join the Residential Compost Program.
- 3. Ensure your room has a recycling and landfill deskside bin. If you don't have either in the room upon arrival, submit a maintenance request.
- 4. Find out where to empty your recycle and landfill bins.
- 5. Invest in higher quality items that will last longer than an academic year:
 - a. Cookware.
 - b. Metal shower caddy.
- 6. Rent big appliances instead of buying new ones.
- 7. Replace single-use items with reusables:
 - a. Grocery bags.
 - b. Tupperware.
 - c. Utensils.
 - d. Water bottles.

Around campus

- 1. Bring a reusable cup to any <u>ASU Starbucks</u> location and receive a dollar off your drink.
- 2. Participate in Ditch the Dumpster.
- 3. Use a reusable cup at a water bottle filling station, or fill up your reusable cup for 99¢ with coffee, tea or soda at the Pod Markets.
