JOSEPH L. ADAMS. 1860

Court of Claims No. 1883. Grant vs U.S., Oct. 1863, p. 147-

Deposition of Joseph L. Adams. The witness being duly sworn says that his name is Joseph L. Adams; his age is twenty-five years; occupation, collection clerk of the Bank of Mutual Redemption, of the city of Boston; his place of residence for the past year, Lynn, in the State of Massachusetts; that he has no interest direct or indirect, in the claim which is the subject of inquiry.....

I went to Arizona in 1860, in the employ of Wm. S. Grant, and arrived at Tucson in the month of June of that year. I served Mr. Grant in the capacity of book-keeper. I left the Territory in April, A. D. 1861.....
