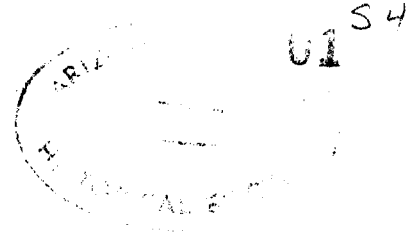


ALEXANDER, GEORGE C.

Property Record of Tucson, compiled by W.S.Oury, 1862. p.60,69.

Lot 118, conveyed by Ramon Castro to Fritz Contzen and by him ~~to~~ sold and conveyed by warrantee deed to said George C. Alexander, consideration four hundred (400) dollars. Bounded and described as follows: Commencing at the Northwest corner of the property of Loreto Higuera and running north along the line of the Plazuela one hundred and eleven (111) feet to the property of Alcario Espinosa, thence east along the line of Espinosa, sixty three and one fourth ( $63\frac{1}{4}$ ) feet, thence south one hundred and five and eleven twelfths ( $105\frac{11}{12}$ ) feet to the north line of the property of Loreto Higuera, thence west with the line of said Higuera fifty seven and three fourths ( $57\frac{3}{4}$ ) feet to the place of beginning. Deed bears date Sept. 15th, 1862
