Infantry, June 14, 1872; promoted to 1st Lieutenant October 23, 1882; served as Regimental Quartermaster from June, 1886 to February, 1889; promoted to Captain, December 29, 1890; was Colonel, 4th Tennessee Volunteer Infantry, Spanish-American War, from July 13, 1898 to May 6, 1899; promoted to Major, 10th U. S. Infantry, July 12, 1899; promoted to Lieutenant Colonel and transferred to 14th U. S. Infantry, October 18, 1902 - - - Commandant of Cadets, University of Arizona, 1915-17; Member, Arizona Pioneers Historical Society, Tucson.
