Arrived In the United States when he was 6 years old; enlisted, age 16, in the 5th New York Infantry, (Colonel Abram Duryee's Zouaves) to serve during the Civil War and was promoted to 1st Lieutenant in that Regiment; received three severe wounds at the first Battle of Bull Run.

After his discharge from the Army he came to Arizona in 1865; listed, U. S. Census, 1870, at Arizona City (Yuma) A.T., age 24, occupation - Clerk in Store, property valued at \$1,200; he was Postmaster at Yuma, in 1873.

Died at Yuma, A.T., June 23, 1880.
