

**GIBSON, HENRY**

Born at Marietta, Washington County, Ohio, March 9, 1830.

Son of John Gibson and \_\_\_\_\_; never married.

Came to Arizona as Private, Company H, 1st California Infantry, April, 1851

Original Member, Society of Arizona Pioneers, Tucson, January 31, 1884.

Comrade, Hegley Post No. 1, G.A.R., Tucson, A.T.,

Admitted from Tucson to U.S. Soldiers Home, Saultelle, California,

November 10, 1898; returned to Tucson for a visit and died in a hack

immediately after leaving the Southern Pacific railroad depot,

June 19, 1901, aged 71.

Buried G.A.R. Cemetery, Tucson, Arizona Has gravestone
