Born at _____, Amelia County, Virginia, January 8, 1815.

Son of Dr. William Graham and Mary (Campbell) Graham

Married Julia Hutchinson at St. Augustine, Florida,
on May 6, 1841.

Children James Duncan (1st Lieutenant, U. S. Army),

Commanded an expedition of several companies that left Chihuahua in September, 1848, and marched across what is now southern Arizona to California; arrived at the mouth of the Gila, November 22, and at Los Angeles early in January, 1849.

Retired as Colonel, 4th U.S. Cavalry, December 15, 1870,

Died at Washington, D. C., on September 12, 1905.

Buried in National Cemetery, Arlington, Virginia.
