~~XXXXXXXXXX~~, born in Columbus, Franklin County, Ohio,

about 1819; married, Nancy Green in Sandusky County, Ohio, March 30, 1837, children, Ellis, Nellie (Mrs. Michael Tingler) and four others.

Enrolled, age 45, on November 2, at Nevada City, Nevada County, California, and mustered in on November 18, 1864, at the Presidio of San Francisco to serve three years as Private in Captain George D. Kendall's Company I, 7th California Infantry; occupation when enlisted, Carpenter; stationed at the Presidio until May, 1865, when he left with the Company for Arizona and marched via Fort Mohave arriving at Fort Whipple in June; was sent to the post hospital suffering from jaundice where he died on January 1, 1866; buried at Fort Whipple, Yavapai County, A.T., with military and masonic honors.
