LORD, RICHARD S prigg c. anby.

Born at Queinatti, ^{Hamilton} Logan County, Ohio, October 26, 1832.

Son of Dr Abiel H. Lord and Letitia ^{McClayd} ~~(Bright)~~ Lord

Married, Mary A. Wright at Queinatti, ^{Hamilton} Logan County, Ohio, on March 18, 1863.

Children, Richard S. & Edith Sheridan (Both died in infancy)

Appointed to West Point from Ohio, 1852 and graduated, 1856.

As 2d Lieutenant, 1st U.S. Dragoons was stationed at Fort Buchanan and Tucson, 1857-60; engaged in skirmish with Apaches near Calabasas, August 26, 1860; engaged in the battles of Valverde, N.M., February 21 and Apache Canyon March 7-8, 1862.

Died at Bellefontaine, Logan County, Ohio, October 15, 1866, aged 34.

Buried Spring Grove Cemetery, Queinatti Ohio.
