Enlisted July 16, 1846, at Council Bluffs as Private, Captain Nelson Higgins Company D, Mormon Battalion; marched across southern Arizona and honorably discharged at Los Angeles, July 16, 1847; settled at Moccasin Spring, A.T., 1864, but left because of Indian troubles in 1866; came from Colonia Diaz, Mexico, to Graham County.

Died at Mesa, Maricopa County, A.T., August 18, 1895, aged 74.
