MARSHALL, EDWARD B.

Born at _____ New York, _____ 18____.

Son of _____ and _____.

Enrolled, age 37, at Quincy, Plumas County, October 18 and mustered in October 23, 1861, at Camp Union near Sacramento to serve 3 years as Private, Captain James H. Whitlock's Company F, 5th California Infantry; went with the Company to Southern California in February, and arrived at Fort Yuma in June, 1862; was at Maricopa Wells from July to September 1862; arrived at Tucson in October, 1862, and assigned to the Quartermaster's Department as Post Carpenter, serving as such until June, 1863; on detached service at Pinos Altos, New Mexico, during July and August, 1864; honorably discharged at Mesilla, New Mexico, November 30, 1864.

Listed, U. S. Census, 1870, at Tucson, A.T., age 53, occupation - Carpenter, property valued at \$200; at the time of his death the Florence Enterprise stated:

Ned Marshall, as he was generally called, came to this Territory with the famous California column about 23 years ago, and has been a resident of Arizona ever since. He was a man of fine physique, and although 72 years of age, did not appear to be more than 50. He was a native of New York, and has two brothers now in business at Lick's slip, New York City.

He was a man above the average in intelligence and possessed many admirable traits of character, which made him friends wherever he went. His friends here took charge of the corpse and interred it in an elegant coffin.
