Listed, Territorial Census, April, 1864, at New Water in the 2d District (Yuma County) age 50, married, family in France, resident in Arizona 1 year, occupation - Miner; the following obituary was printed in the Prescott Arizona Enterprise on August 3, 1879:

Mr. Frank Quinet, a patient in the County Hospital, died during the night, from rupture of a blood vessel. He was but recently admitted, having come from Willow Creek, where he has a ranch; he was a native of France, aged 67 years, and came to this country in 1862. For many years he kept the Willow Springs Station, on the Dos Palmas road, west of the Colorado River. He was buried at 1 o'clock.

Died at Prescott, Yavapai County, A. T., August 2, 1879.
