Graduated at West Point and appointed 2d Lieutenant, 3d U.S. Infantry, July 1, 1844; brevet 1st Lieutenant for gallant and meritorious conduct in the battles of Contreras and Churubusco, Mexico, August 20, 1847. As 1st Lieutenant and Captain, 3d U.S. Infantry, was on frontier duty in New Mexico from 1850 to 1860; stationed at Fort Defiance, 1851-54; on Navajo expedition, 1858, and at Fort Defiance, 1858-59. Resigned, May 30, 1861, and retired to his farm near Petersville, Montgomery County, Maryland.
