Recommended by Senator James Wilson Grimes and appointed from Iowa by President Lincoln as Chief Justice of the United States Court for the Territory of Arizona on August 22, 1863; reappointed by President Johnson on February 5, 1868, and served until April 14, 1870.

He overtook Governor Goodwin and the other Territorial officials at Fort Larned, Kansas, and arrived in Arizona with them on December 29, 1863; listed, Territorial Census, April, 1864, at Prescott, A.T., age 40, born in Pennsylvania, married, family in Iowa, resident in Arizona 3 months, occupation - Chief Justice.
