

WALLEN, HENRY DAVIES

1820-30

Born at Savannah, Chatham County, Georgia, April 19, 1819.

Son of Elias Wallen and _____, who is said to have been the daughter of ^{Samuel} G. J. DeCamp, Surgeon General, U.S. Army.

Married, Laura Louise DeCamp (1827-1915) at Jefferson Barracks, Missouri, on April 25, 1844.

Children, George E. and others

As Major, 7th U.S. Infantry, served as Acting Assistant Inspector General of the Department of New Mexico, 1862-64; as Lieutenant Colonel, 14th U.S. Infantry, was in command of the District of the Gila, April 26 to June 10 and of the District of Arizona, June 10 to August 11, 1866. Died at New York City, December 2, 1886, aged 67.

Buried ~~in~~ Cemetery, West Point, New York.

Camp Wallen, on Babocomari Creek, A.T., named for him.
