Naturalized as an American citizen at Wellsboro, Tioga County, Pennsylvania, September 14, 1854.

Went to California, 1858; Came to Arizona, 1863.

Listed, U. S. Census, July 13, 1870, at Cerro Colorado, Pima County, A.T., age 42, born in England, occupation, Miner, property valued at \$400, wife, Rimola, age 20, son, Manuel, age 3.
