






Programmatic Assumptions


- 1. Undergrad population reduces 11% (36,150 to 33,800) Graduate increases 51% (9,300 to 13,200)
- 2. Research increase from \$45M to \$300M
- On campus housing increases from 14% to 35% of FTE student population (6,400 to 15,000 beds)







Signalized Intersections


Option to realign Packard with McAllister and Sixth with Stadium

Remove Terrace west of Rural


New Signalized Pedestrian Crossing or Intersection




Rural and University Sketch










Existing Rio Salado Site Section
