Residence Hall Safe Tips:

Always lock your doors even if you are just going down the hall or next door for a few minutes.

If you see someone or something suspicious, call the ASU Police Department immediately to report it.

Never leave external doors propped open. If you find a propped open door, close it!

Always use the 'buddy system' when walking outside after dark.

Activate SafeWalk so friends or family members can view your step-by-step progress on a map. Chat live with your designated emergency contacts during your trip. Deactivate Safewalk once you arrive safely.

Friends and family can also virtually walk an app user home. The app's SafeWalk feature uses GPS-tagged monitoring to track an app user's progress on a Webbased map. Once a user has reached his or her destination safely, the feature easily can be deactivated.

As a part of Live Safe app, you can activate SafeWalk so friends and family can monitor your progress on a map and you can chat live with designated emergency contacts as you walk. Deactivate Safe-Walk once you arrive safely.

SAFETY TIPS FOR YOUR PERSONAL BELONGINGS

The ASU Police Department would like to remind members of our community to make sure their personal belongings are kept safe. Property crime (theft, vehicle and residential burglaries, etc.) have increased during the past month. The following is a list of recommendations we ask you to consider:

- Lock the front door to your residence when leaving, even if roommates are still home or if you are only going to be gone for a moment.
- Use caution when opening your door to anyone you do not know or recognize.
- Never leave personal property (laptops, cell phones, backpacks)
 unattended while in public places; it only takes a moment for someone
 to grab it and walk way.
- Always lock your vehicle doors and roll up your windows, which will deter anyone from quickly accessing your vehicle.
- Hide valuables out of sight within your vehicle or take them with you when parking at ASU.
- Be aware of your surroundings to keep yourself and your belongings safe.
