Personal Electronic Thefts at Sun Devil Fitness Center



- Several thefts of personal electronics have occurred over the past few weeks at the Sun Devil Fitness Center
- The majority of these thefts have occurred in the basketball gyms from unattended book bags while the victims are playing sports.
- A subject described as a black-male, approx. 19-20 years old, 6'2" to 6'4", approx. 170lbs, with dreadlocks, and gaped teeth has been seen in the area immediately prior to the thefts on several occasions.
- ASU Police recommends securing any valuable items in a secured locker to reduce chance of loss.
